Children's Services

Oak-Leyden programs served 295 children from birth to age five from 26 different communities in 2018, with 113 graduating from the **Early Intervention Program** for ages three and under.

250 children with developmental disabilities or delays received direct therapy from physical, occupational, speech-language and/or developmental therapists. 16 children received professional screenings.

11 children gained hands-on experience with instruments through **Music Together**® classes and 32 children came to therapeutic drop-in playgroups.

100% of children showed gains in one or more specific area of development.

Children's Services provides support for children with developmental disabilities from birth to age five and their families. Therapy is provided on-site and in a child's natural environment, as staff work with each child's caregivers to take advantage of everyday learning opportunities. Children also benefit from therapeutic playgroups.





Bevy Lu's Story

Cheryl, the parent of a participant in our Children's Services, was in Maryland for a funeral and went into premature labor. Her daughter, Bevy Lu, was born at 23 weeks and remained in the hospital in Maryland for four months.

Doctors told Cheryl her daughter would need Early Intervention services. As soon as she returned to Chicago, she contacted our organization. When Cheryl came to Oak-Leyden, she quickly gained an extended family.

The therapies Oak-Leyden provided have helped support Cheryl and her family. "Susan Klinger has been amazing with physical therapy and Katie Crehan is a wonderful speech therapist," says Cheryl.

Bevy Lu started life at 1 lbs 5 oz. Two years later, she's a healthy 20 pounds! The family is looking forward to seeing Oak-Leyden's new occupational therapist, Abigail Koning.

Salim's Story



Salim is one of the connecting forces that makes our Lifelong Learning Center in Oak Park the social and community hub it is. Each day, he comes to our program with enthusiasm and a desire to do new things. He is a helper, a listener and a volunteer.

Salim, because of who he is and because of the values his family instilled in him, has the ability to seek out new things, go new places and meet new people. His empathy toward others and his personal energy inspires his peers to try new activities.

Community Living Services & Lifelong Learning Centers

In 2018, Oak-Leyden provided family-style housing to 51 participants in 12 community integrated living arrangements, as well as intermittent support to 3 participants, through our **Community Living Services**.

898 medical visits were made through our organizationally operated **Clinic Services**.

134 individuals participated in our **Adult Lifelong Learning Centers**, where they learned life and vocational skills.

41 community jobs were secured or maintained through our **Supported Employment Program**.



Residents in Oak-Leyden community integrated living arrangements receive 24-hour support and care that promotes their personal autonomy and physical well-being. Oak-Leyden also operates two adult day programs in Oak Park and Elmwood Park, where participants with developmental disabilities learn the skills they need to live as independently as possible.



Where Do Your Contributions Go?



In 2018, contributions from public and private sources helped make Oak-Leyden's programs and services even better:

Children with developmental disabilities were able to engage in therapeutic drop-in playgroups alongside their typically developing peers in a newly renovated learning and play space.

Lifelong Learning Centers in Oak Park and Elmwood Park installed new sensory spaces for adults with sensory disorders such as autism through the support of the Healthy Communities Foundation.

Voices of Oak-Leyden, a choir composed entirely of adults with developmental disabilities, gave dynamic performances throughout Cook County.

Adults with developmental disabilities gained supported employment opportunities in our communities at places such as Aramark, Costco, Delta-Sonic, Jewel-Osco, Portillo's, Sam's Club, Target, and Walgreens.
