CILAdoption Program

Join Oak-Leyden in supporting adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) in our Community Living Services participants live in family-style homes that allow for attention to their individual needs.

Through Oak-Leyden's Community Living Services, adult participants enjoy comfort and safety in group homes located in Chicago's near west suburbs. Residents are provided 24-hour support and care that promote personal independence and physical well-being. Community Integrated Living Arrangements (CILAs) provide a path laden with developmental stepping stones to independence for each individual. Participants are able to build a foundation on which they grow and live as independently as possible, participating in communities as their neighbors do.

What is a CILA?

Our 12 CILA homes create safe and supportive environments for each of our residents. With low residence turnovers and a caring 24/7 staff, our clients develop friendships, respect, and independence. Our residents regularly learn new skills through cooking, housekeeping, personal upkeep, and connecting with their neighborhoods.

Why CILAdoption?

When you participate in the CILAdoption prorgram you support inclusion, integration, and independence for adults with IDD in west suburban Chicago. Your support helps fund opportunities, house improvements, and general home care. Support of a CILA will directly impact the participants who live in the home.

For an annual commitment of \$10,000 you can you adopt a CILA. When you do a CILAdoption you get to:
